# Neighborly reminders: Clean up after pets

Cranberry Twp. pet owners are subject to Ordinance #2005-362, which specifies, among other things:

- "Animals shall not be permitted to commit a nuisance by allowing a dog/cat to secrete any solid waste on the property of another"
- "An owner or person in control shall have physical control of the animal when off their property, by means of a leash, lead, cord, chain, or cage"

### Keep your post lamp lit:

It's a security issue! Since we only have street lights at the entrances and along Powell Road, the post lamps in our yards are the only things providing illumination for people walking at night, and a well-lit yard is less of a target for potential vandals.



Please replace lights as soon as they burn out. LED lights are a worthwhile investment because they last for years. Also, if the photocell is broken, replacements are available at hardware stores.

#### Keep walkways clear:

Sidewalks must be kept clear. Trees must have at least 9 feet of vertical clearance. It's each homeowner's responsibility to keep make sure enough clearance is provided.



### Yard work get ahead of you this year?

With all the rain we've had, it's easy to see how the weeds can get out of control. Yard waste pickup ends the 1<sup>st</sup> week of December, so if you want to use what's left of the nice weather to spruce up the yard and clean out those pesky weeds, now's the time! If you fill your cart, you can buy extra yard waste bags at the Cranberry Twp. Parks and Recreation Dept. Customer Service Desk at the Municipal Building (Five 30 gallon bags for \$2.00). They also sell them at home improvement stores, or Costco has a 25 pack for \$7.99.

#### **School Bus Etiquette**



Mornings are a hectic time for everyone, but remember, now that school has started, buses coming through the neighborhood can cause extra congestion. Seneca Valley School District asks that we follow these simple safety rules:

#### Parents:

- Cars waiting at bus stop should not block driveways.
- Park at least 15 feet from the stop sign.
- All cars on the same side of the street.
- No parking on Powell Rd.

- Observe laws when stopping for school bus.
- Be patient! If possible, adjust your schedule so you're not trying to leave when the bus is arriving.
